EDUCATION

Helping children and youth achieve their potential through education.



\$1 a week provides more than 3 hours of mentoring to help youth stay in school and achieve.

INCOME

Helping people become financially stable and independent.



\$5 a week provides 4 hours of services to help seniors manage finances and remain safely in their homes.

HEALTH

Improving physical and behavioral health.

\$10 a week provides 80 seniors with a home delivered meal.



BASIC & EMERGENCY NEEDS

Providing a safety net of services.



\$10 a week makes available 5 days/nights of safety, support and housing for victims of domestic violence.
