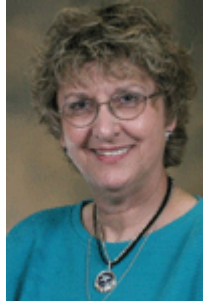


ANNOUNCING UNITED WAY'S 2009-2010 CAMPAIGN LOANED EXECUTIVES
